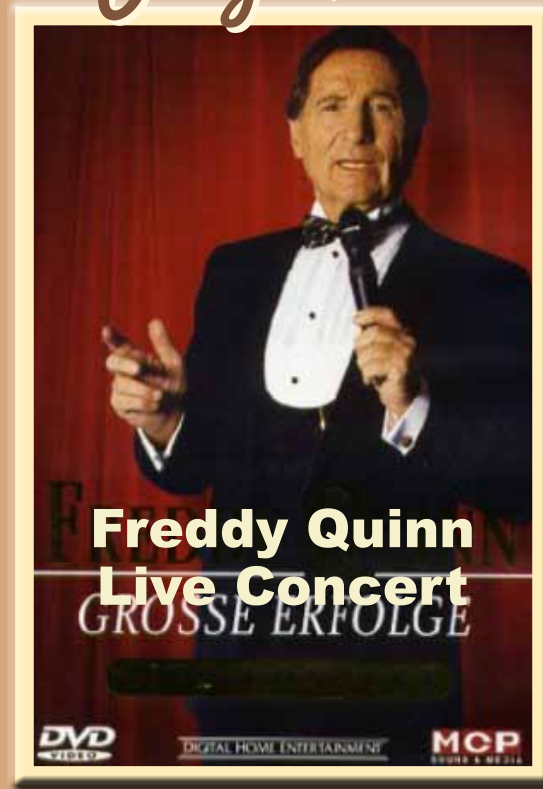

Setting a Guinness World Record

On May 4, 2013, the Teutonia Club of Windsor in association with the GTEV Chiemgau Windsor, came together to try to break a Guinness Book of World Record. Which one? The most couples dancing under a Maypole, in tracht, at the same time. The old record was 170 – that's 85 couples. It would be challenging, but they were up to it. But let's back it up, to the beginning of the 4-day festival.

On Thursday, May 2nd, the Mai-pole was paraded through the city of Windsor until it reached its final destination of the Teutonia Club. The pole was erected to grand fanfare, and the weekend was off and running. Friday evening was an evening of dancing and celebration – they even brought our own Golden Keys down they to help whoop it up!

Saturday was the big day though. People came from all over to register and be part of this once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. There were people from all over the Windsor and Detroit areas, as well as some from Kitchener and Toronto. They lined up, handed in their participation tickets, and entered the restricted area where the record would be set. Everyone knew the dance already – a video had been put on their website so everyone could learn it before showing up. Once everyone was in the circle, the dance began. And what a sight it was!

They dance for 5 minutes, while the Guinness judges watched carefully to make sure everyone was dancing non-stop and doing the correct step. After 7 min (they did a bit extra), the horn sounded, and the dance was over. Was the record set? After careful tabulations, 220 people participated in the event. That's 110 couples. The record had been unofficially set. Now the Guinness judges would view the videos, count the registration names, and review everything. After 4-6 weeks, if everything came together, the record would be

official.

Sunday was another day of dancing and celebration, this time concentrating on families. All in all, it was a wonderful weekend, and a unique opportunity that shouldn't have been missed. I've checked their website, and they're having another Maifest next year on the first weekend in May. They may not try to set the World Record again, but it will make for another great weekend. You should go down and check it out!
