Vize-Praesidentenbericht

Ich hoffe, ihr seid alle ins Neue Jahr gut eingerutscht und habt Weihnachten, Silvester, sowie das kalte Januarwetter gut ueberstanden. Nach dem Schluss des Jahres moechte ich auf 2014 zurueckblicken und was wir im neuen Jahr vorhaben. Im 2014 waren sowohl Positives als Negatives zu bemerken.

Im 2014 hatten wir einen erheblichen Zugang von Hallenvermietungen im Vergleich mit 2013 (103 vs 68). Demzufolge flossen \$15.000 mehr in die Klubkassen. In 2013 gab es 15 Hochzeiten. In 2014 waren es 21. Fuer 2015 sind schon 14 Hochzeiten gebucht.

In 2014 haben wir mehr Veranstaltungen mit Live-Musik gebucht, meistens wo wir die Einnahmen an der Tuer mit dem Musikveranstalter teilen. Einnahmen von der Bar bleiben dem Klub allein. Obwohl solche Veranstaltungen nicht immer viel Geld reinbringen, koennen wir jeden Dollar gebrauchen, besonders wenn die Hallen ansonsten leer stehen wuerden.

Oktoberfest 2014 ist wieder erfolgreich verlaufen und das Einkommen lag um Vorjahresniveau. Gluecklicherweise ist es dem Klub gelungen, die Ausgaben und Unkosten zu verringern. Am Ende ist der Nettogewinn leicht gestiegen.

Neue Strassenschilder an der King Street sowie an der Weber Street wurden errichtet und haben das "Gesicht" des Klubs deutlich verbessert und neue Kunden angelockt. Das Klub-Mahnmal an der King Street findet immer wieder Interesse von Klubmitgliedern und Besuchern.

Seitdem der Transylvania Klub nicht mehr bei uns ansaessig ist, haben wir es schwer zu schaffen, das fehlende Einkommen dieser Geldquelle wiedergutzumachen. Die Konkurrenz macht es uns auch schwer, Hallen zu vermieten. In 2015 werden wir unser Bestes versuchen, Kosten zu druecken und Einkommen zu steigern.

In Januar hielten wir erneut einen Tag der offenen Tuer fuer alle Hochzeitsinteressenten. Einige Hochzeiten wurden infolge gebucht. Wir werden die Live-Musik Veranstaltungen weiter buchen. Da ist wenig Risiko, nur Einkommen, ob an der Bar oder an der Tuer als Eintritt (geteilt mit dem Veranstalter).

Fuer 2015 hat unser Kuechenchef einige Vorschlaege parat. Die Speisenauswahl wird erweitert, mit Premiumangeboten. Andere Fleischsorten, mehr Auswahl und zusaetzliche Dienstleistungen werden angeboten. Kunden duerfen nun ein Bueffetessen bestellen. Speiseplaene werden so flexibel wie moeglich zusammengestellt um jeden Kundenwunsch zufriedenzustellen. Als Profi-Koch hat sich unser neuer Kuechenchef schon bewiesen.

Im Februar am Freitag den 6. kann man ein leckeres Fisch + Pommes Essen geniessen, und zwar an jedem Freitag fuer die naechsten Monate. Wenn das erfolgreich verlauft, dann werden wir das Essen fortsetzen.

Verbesserungen in den Waschräumen und den Hallen werden kontinuierlich unternommen, um alles instandzuhalten.

Hoffentlich in 2015 koennen mehr Mitglieder unsere Veranstaltungen besuchen. In den letzten Jahren ging die Zahl der Teilnehmer immer wieder zurueck. Bei der letzten Veranstaltung, dem Miss Schwaben Gala, waren erfreulicherweise ueber 200 Gaeste zu vermelden. Dieser Abend war in den letzten Jahren nie so gut besucht. Bitte, weiter so ! Wenn unsere eigene Mitglieder den Klub nicht mehr unterstuetzen, dann muessen wir bald zu dem schweren Entschluss kommen, entweder den Klub als solcher weiterzufuehren oder die Tuere zu schliessen. Ich bin fest ueberzeugt, wir sind nicht so weit gekommen. Wir haben noch viele treue Mitglieder und Freunde. Wir bitten nur um ihre weitere Unterstuetzung.

Als Vize-Praesident habe ich immer ein offenes Ohr fuer ihre Anregungen. Ich freue mich auf die naechsten Jahre und auf ihr zahlreiches Erscheinen bei der naechsten Klubveranstaltung.

Vice-President's Report

Happy new year! I hope that you survived Christmas and New Year's and cold weather of January.

Now that 2014 is over I thought I'd share with you how we did last year and what we plan to do for 2015

2014 had some positives and of course had some problems too. The positives that we saw in 2014 were an increase on hall rentals from 2013 where we had a total of 68 hall rentals. 2014 we finished off with a total of 103 rentals which is roughly about a \$15,000 increase in hall revenue. Of those total rentals 2013 only saw 15 weddings at the club. 2014 brought 21 weddings to the Schwaben Club and in 2015 we are already at 14 wedding scheduled to be at our club. Some of the other initiatives that we did in 2014 was to do more live music acts at the club where we would work an agreement with the band for portion of the hall ticket revenue and we would retain the bar. The shows are typically not very large but they are continually growing and showing us that we can make extra money to help a supplement the club when there are no hall rentals.

Oktoberfest 2014 also saw us keeping the same amount of revenue as the previous Oktoberfest. With the hard work of the office and the committee we have managed to keep our costs down therefore keeping our profit margin higher.

Another positive that we saw in 2014 was the long-awaited renewal of our front signs on King Street and Weber Street. The continual upgrading of our monument up on King Street and adding it to some of our club events.

One of the problems we needed to overcome in 2014 was the departure of the Transylvania Club, leaving us a huge amount of money to make up. Unfortunately, even with the extra hall revenues, we came short by quite a bit of money for 2014. My hope is that in 2015 hall rentals will continue to go up and we will strive to make extra money at every turn and cut costs where ever we can.

In 2015 we will continue to try to increase our business!! With the new signs on King Street and Weber Street we have already seen walk in traffic increase. We also had our wedding show open house in January which brought in more people than the year before. With these efforts, we are hoping that rental business will continue to increase for us. We are also continuing with our live band program where we will let live music rent the club for a minimal cost. There's no risk to the club losing money and we will make the money on the bar and a little bit on the admission tickets. These events are a good filler for dates when the halls have not been rented.

Other new thoughts and ideas for 2015 are: An upgraded dinner menu with the new chef leading the charge. The club will now off for hot buffets for parties. We will also continue to offering the clubs favourites plus add a premium type of cooking so that when people come to the club we are flexible as possible. In a very competitive market we need to find every way possible to make us standout. I believe the new chef is on the right track. The club has received many positive reviews about his cooking and I believe that 2015 will be the year of the kitchen; people will talk about how good the food is at the Schwaben Club all around the Region.

Other new initiatives will be a fish fry every Friday starting February 6 and going to at least April. In April we will then see how great attendance was and make the decision whether to continue. It is my belief that Friday Fish Fry will become a staple at our club.

2015 will also see improvements in our bathrooms, our bars and halls; continual improvement will help us modernize so that we can still be a major player in the hall rental industry.

2015 hopefully will be the year that a majority of our membership will start to attend our functions. In 2013 and 2014 we saw a declining member participation. With the improvements to our food and the halls, I am sure that the members will come back. We saw some evidence of that at the end of January at Miss

Schwaben; the attendance numbers were over 200 which has not happened in many, many years.

It is important to have hall rental income coming from all sorts of people in the community but it is still more important to remember that the club is still a German, Schwaben culture club supported by its membership and if the membership doesn't support the club then we end up having a problem. We would then need to ask the question ``why are the doors still openj.

I do know for a fact that our membership is very caring and understanding and they do not wish not to have our club closed so with your guidance and support I am sure the club will continue for many years.

As vice president I will be here to listen to your thoughts and your concerns and hopefully we will continue to grow as a family for many years to come.

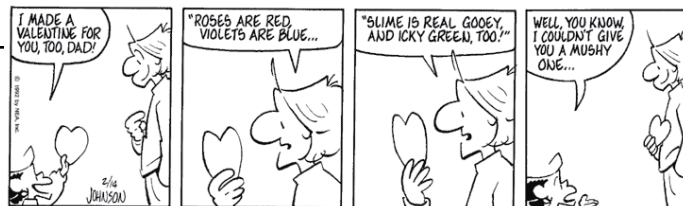

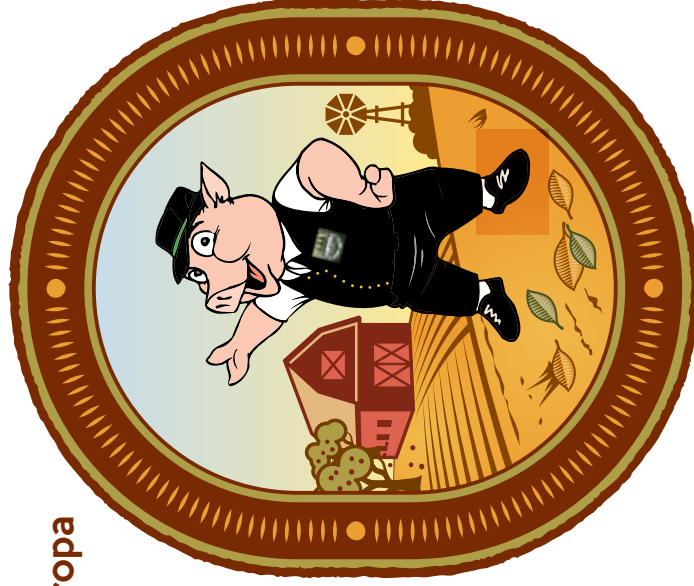

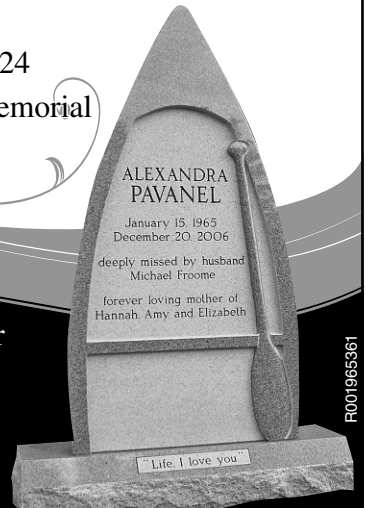
