

The year end is coming up within a few weeks as I write this and when you receive this report. Please think of paying our 2019 memberships EARLY because there is a new change. There are some NEW Rates that will come into effect January 1st, 2019. It has been 3 years since the last Rates increase.

They are: **2019 Membership Rates**

Family: \$85

Single: \$60

Student: \$25

Seniors: \$40

The Late Fee is increased to \$30. Late fees are an indicator that memberships need to be paid sooner than later. The Late fee will be in effect on April 1st. No change on the Student and Seniors Rates.

For the Family and Single new rates: Pay ahead for your 2019 membership before Jan 1st and you will pay the 2018 rates before they go up.

You can also pay anytime until January 1st your membership during the day at the club office or at the November and December members meetings on Nov 14th and Dec 12th.

For the Non-Exempt Sick Benefit Members: When you pay your 2019 membership- your \$12 fee is also due at same time.


