Board of Directors Job Descriptions (Abbreviated)

Haus und Hof (Building and Lands) - Work with the Club Manager to oversee the maintenance and repair of the building and lands. Conduct minor repair work if possible. Keep a list of skilled trade people (in and out of the club) that can conduct larger scale repair work.

Flag Bearer – ensure flags are properly displayed at all necessary events and parades. Assist 'Haus and Hof' with maintenance and repair work.

Communications Director – Ensure a consistent message over the various methods of external communications including website, social media, Nachrichten, posters, newspaper advertisements, radio/television advertisements.

Entertainment Director – organize social events internal (German Concerts) and external (Picnic) to the club. Serve as Executive liaison with the Freundschaftgruppe, Bowlers, and Table Tennis Groups.

Cultural Referent – organize cultural events internal (Grundungsfest, Schlachtfest, Christmas Luncheon) and external (Thanksgiving Day Parade, Ontario Trachtenfest, International Landestrachtenfest, Jugendlager, Welttreffen) to the club. Serve as Executive liaison with the Frauengruppe and Dance Groups, report on status of their events (Miss Schwaben, Ladies Grundungsfest, Spaghetti Fundraiser, Viennese Ball, Mother's Day Luncheon).

Archivist – Maintain artifacts within Archives, Library and Museum. Stock and maintain re-sale merchandise, club pins. Keep inventory of all moveable property of the club, and keys.

Treasurer – Work with the Office Administrator and Accountant to monitor income and expenses of the club and its umbrella groups.

Membership Secretary – Serve as liaison with the Sick Benefit Association, and keep a record of income and expenses for the same. Maintain membership records for General Membership, Sick Benefit and Death Benefit; deal with those members not in good standing.

Recording Secretary - Keep meeting minutes. Maintain up to date copies of "Policies and Procedures" for reference during meetings.

Vice President – Work with the Club Manager to oversee the day-to day business, including staffing, food and beverage sales, rentals, and regular sales events (pool league, karaoke, fish fry).

President – Assist and support above to ensure work is getting done. Facilitate internal meetings. Serve as liaison with Canadian and US Verbands, KW Oktoberfest, local German Clubs and Associations.
