To all Club Members,

Recently, Constitution Amendments were approved by the Sick Benefit Association. Our Constitution consisted of, and still does, a 2-tier membership. Those being the Canadian Sick Benefit Association Members, and the Schwaben Club Members. This is now clearly defined and outlined in the newly amended Constitution. Copies can be obtained from the Club office.

One of the main Constitution changes recently made, is that Club Members of **any** gender, and/or are over age 50, can now apply to become a member of the "Sick Benefit Association".

I wholly support this change of inclusion and the removal of the age cap. Current dues/fees to join the Sick Benefit Association, are \$12.00 per year and you must obtain a medical certificate from your physician for review by the Sick Benefit Committee.

Sick Benefit Members are eligible to apply for financial support should they become sick or injured, causing you to be unable to work.

This benefit was very helpful to our family members such as our great grandparents, grandparents, parents, who immigrated here from the homeland, to help and support these families in times of need.

Also, only the Sick Benefit Members who have been a member for at least 3 full months and are 18 years of age, have the right to vote (see Article 7.5) on anything regarding the "Property" of the Association. (see Article 14.1) This includes, but does not limit, components like selling or not selling our building and land, as well as the approval of major repairs and/or upgrades.

In addition, only Sick Benefit members have a voice and a vote regarding any future Constitution changes, (see Articles 17.1 and 17.2). Personally, I hope to see ongoing future discussions regarding possible additional changes and/or updates to our Constitution.

As a "club member only", you cannot claim the sick benefit, nor do have a voice or the right to vote on the aforementioned matters.

Over the past many years, I have seen and worked with many dedicated "club only" members who gave and continue to give, so much of their time and effort to preserve our Donauschwaben culture, heritage and club, and assist in running and supporting non cultural business which brings in much needed revenue in order to sustain the home of our beloved Schwaben Club. However, in the overall scheme of things, they don't have a voice or vote on some very paramount matters.

I feel that it is important that ALL members have the same rights of having a voice and a vote regarding such paramount matters, in order to determine what is in the best interest of the Sick Benefit Association Members and the Club Members together. Now, many of our "Club Members", who did not before, now have the opportunity to join the Sick Benefit Association so that they too, can be heard and to have a vote on some very important matters of our club.

I have already submitted my application to join the Sick Benefit Association, which hopefully will have been approved by the time you read this, and I would like to encourage all "club members only" to consider applying to become a member of the "Sick Benefit Association".

SHARING OF OUR PAST

Our members have asked us to make sure we try to record the history of our senior members so we can learn and understand our past better. We are going to continue to take time to record interviews and share those discussions with all of you as a new addition to the Nachrichten. If any member is interested in speaking to a Club member to record their memories please email schwaben@kitchenerschwabenclub.com or leave your name at the office and someone will contact you to arrange a time to talk.

We will kick off this new initiative this off by using portions of an interview taken last year by Shay Herold for the Oma Abt essay. She interviewed her great grandmother Marion (Marianna) Nuxoll (nee Laub).

"I was born in Vizejdia, Romania on April 2, 1921 and I arrived in Canada in April of 1938, I was 17 and had come to Kitchener because my parents had moved here 10 years before that. They moved here to make money and had thought that they would move back home to buy more land which is what my grandparents did (they had moved to Philadelphia and had worked there for 10 years and moved back). But because of the war the economy was not good, my parents didn't make the money they needed, so they stayed in Canada and I joined my parents.

I remember when I travelled to Canada, my uncle made my Dad summer sausage and I packed it so well in my bag. It was a big expense for my Uncle, and I was happy to bring the gift. When I arrived in Halifax, a man that was working there inspected my bag and saw the sausage and took it from me. I was so disappointed I couldn't give it to my father."

"What I remember about my village is that we were good at working farmland. We worked hard, and our people were friendly. All the kids would say God bless you as they walked by.

I would like this generation of Schwaben people to remember what their families tell them about how we lived and to try to hold onto those traditions as long as they can. My village was small, the people were friendly, we knew everyone and their business. You talked to everyone. It reminds me of the Schwaben Club now. It is like a second family. The traditions are important to keep. I loved Kirchweih, it was 3 days and 3 nights of dancing. The boys wore the white shirts and ribbons on their arms, the hats looked great – the men would pop up when they danced, like a rooster. So, keeping the culture and our way of life is important.

I would also say that life was simpler back home, I didn't have much, but life in some ways was nicer with no money. We grew our own vegetables and made our own meat. I remember enjoying my feather pillows. Here some people work to live but we led a basic life in our village, and it was a good life. So, remember to enjoy what you have."
