### **President's Report**

When evaluating what to do for the upcoming social and cultural events at the club, the board in consultation with membership decided to cancel Schlachtfest in September and Oktoberfest festivities at the club in October. The decision was based on a preference towards social responsibility rather than revenue generation, and avoiding potential customer/member disappointment (these celebrations / festivals are traditionally full of singing, dancing and Gemutlichkeit, and we cannot do them adequate justice given the present safety restrictions). Anyone that already purchased tickets can receive a full refund from the office.

What we will do instead is provide themed restaurant service on Saturday nights (we will continue with our Friday night Fish Fry due to popular demand) following recommended Regulatory Agency safety procedures. For example, for the evening of September 26<sup>th</sup>, when Schlachtfest would have been held, we will look at adding specialty pork products to the menu. During the traditional Oktoberfest weekends, we will offer Oktoberfest themed menus. Menu details will be posted online as they are developed, as well as information on whether indoor and/or outdoor seating will be available (weather dependent).

In terms of Monthly Membership Meetings, the plan is to hold these on a regular ongoing basis. Just a reminder that we need to appoint an election committee in September and hold elections in November.

Each of the Untergruppen (Frauengruppe, Donau Dancers, Schwaben Dancers, Jugend/Kinder groups, Freundschaftsgruppe) will decide on their own what they will do based on their respective membership input as long as the same safety procedures are followed.

As a final comment, keep an eye out for this year's virtual Oktoberfest – if all goes well, we will have several of our members highlighting cultural and social elements of our Donauschwaben heritage.

Wir werden aber thematischen Restaurantbetrieb Samstag abends { wir werden unseren Fisch Fry für Freitag auf angeregter nachfrage wieder aufnehmen } natürlich mit den angeordneten Sicherheitsvorschriften . Zum Beispiel für den Abend des 26. September { das vorgesehene Schlachtfest } haben wir geplant , speziell ein Schweinefleisch Menü zu servieren . Während der traditionellen Oktoberwochenenden werden wir Oktoberfest Menü's haben .Die vorgesehenen Menü's werden online bekannt gegeben und auch die Informationen ob je nach Wetterlage die Veranstaltungen drinnen oder draussen stattfinden .

Es ist vorgesehen die monatlichen Mitgliederversammlungen beizubehalten . Als Erinnerung , wir müssen einen Wahlausschuss im September bilden , für die anstehende Wahl im November .
