2020 is finally over – what a year. I hope everyone at least enjoyed the holidays as best they could. A special thank you goes out to those that helped out with the Virtual Christmas Concert – the feedback was extremely positive and (last I checked) we had nearly 3,000 views on Facebook. We also created a YouTube Channel where you can go to view the Concert as well as a few of our videos from this past Oktoberfest (when on YouTube, search for Schwaben Club Channel and subscribe). The Club will continue to add content to the channel, and we look forward to sharing our culture and traditions through this new format too.

For 2021, there is a sense of cautious optimism as vaccines are being rolled out. For our part, we will continue to plan for every event until such time as we know we will not be able to have it. If we are projected to be in the Red (Control) or Grey (Lockdown) levels at the time of the event, the event will unfortunately need to be cancelled. Schwaben Profile: [Hans-Peter] Hansi Müller

Müller was an accomplished midfielder playing his club football in Germany, Italy, and Austria over the course of a fifteen-year career (beginning with his hometown *VfB Stuttgart* and ending in Innsbruck with *FC Swarovski Tirol*). Among his 42 international appearances, he represented Germany at both the 1980 European Championship (champion) and the World Cup 1982 (runner up). An elegant playmaker, technically stellar and dangerous in front of the goal, Müller was compared to the great Franz Beckenbauer by no less than Pele. Off the pitch, "*schöne Hansi*" was a charismatic heartthrob; indeed, with his swarthy good looks, he was considered "*das erste 'Teenie-Idol' des deutschen Fußballs*" (as he noted, at the peak of his popularity he needed 250,000 autograph cards a year to keep up with his fans).
