It was a pivotal decade as the Canadian Sick Benefit Association was founded. The first year, 1931, saw 3 men hold the position of President and a total of 10 men called themselves President that decade including: W. Gross, J. Martin, M. Neu, M. Potje, W. Harth, M. Licker, M. Stuprich, F. Kaspereck, F. Schultz, and J. Willing. In the early days they had meetings at the homes of the members and shared space with the Saxon Club. A Youth Group was formed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year and of course dances were held. It was there that many Schwaben members found their life partners. In 1933, a German school and Theatre group were started. In 1935, the Ladies Auxiliary was formed, and the bingo nights and bazaars were started to raise money for the Club. The first Trachtenfest was also held that year. In 1937, the Club held a weekend Flag consecration, the program is shown below. In 1939 due to the beginning of WW2, the Club was forced to stop activities for awhile. The Club was still able to assist members who were no longer able to support their families due to illness or injury.

Zum Tode von George Kraehling Der Präsident der Donauschwaben in Kanada, George Frank Kraehling geboren am 25. Dezember 1961 in New York/USA ist am 29. Dezember 2020 im Alter von 59 Jahren überraschend auf einer Autobahn in den USA verstorben. George war mit seinem Hund auf der Fahrt von Kanada in sein Haus in Florida. Als amerikanischer Staatsbürger durfte er in die USA einreisen, seine

Frau Mary hat die kanadische Staatsbürgerschaft und musste wegen der Corona Vorschriften in den USA zuhause bleiben. Der plötzliche Tod ereilte George auf der Autobahn.

Die Vorfahren des Verstorbenen stammten aus Ex-Jugoslawien, sein Großvater wurde im Jahre 1943 von den Partisanen rschossen.Seine Eltern Ann und George sind George in die Ewigkeit vorausgegangen.

Verheiratet war George mit Mary, geb. Spencer, der Ehe entstammen eine Tochter und ein Sohn.

Als engagiertes Mitglied der Vereinigung der Donauschwaben in Kanada war George ehemaliger Präsident des Schwaben Clubs Kitchener und aktives Mitglieder der Tanzgruppe "Donau Dancers". Ihm lagen die Pflege und Erhalt des Überlieferten Kulturgutes, der Sitten und des Brauchtums seiner Vorfahren besonders am Herzen. Dies bewies er auch mit der Teilnahme am Welttreffen im Juli/August 2019 in Baja/Ungarn und Hatzfeld/Rumänien. Nach

dem Anton Baumann nicht mehr für das Amt des Präsidenten der Donauschwaben in Kanada kandidierte wurde George F. Kraehling zu seinem Nachfolger gewählt. Als amtierender Präsident der Donauschwaben in Kanada gehört er auch dem Präsidium des Weltdachverbandes der Donauschwaben an. Bei der leider verschobenen Hauptversammlung, sollte unser Freund und Landsmann zu



einem der Vizepräsidenten des Weltdachverbandes gewählt werden. Beruflich war der Verstorbene Projektmanager bei der Firma Stantec Engineering.

Bei dieser Firma war er 28 Jahre beschäftigt. Die Trauerfeier fand am 07 Januar 2021 statt, die Urnenbeisetzung wird im Familienkreis zu einem späterem Termin stattfinden. Unser Mitgefühl gilt seiner Frau und allen Familienangehörigen. GEORGE FRANK KRAEHLING möge in Gottes Frieden ruhen.
