Kirchweih is Saturday September 17th. Decoration of untergruppen Rosemary Straus will be Thursday, Sept.15th. Hall decoration takes place Friday, September 16, at 8:00 pm.

OUR CLUB'S DONAUSCHWABEN KIRCHWEIH

This year, Kirchweih is being hosted by both the Frauengruppe and the Club. We are working together to create a wonderful event for all to attend. There will be a few added 'extras' which we are introducing. Extras planned are the Blessing of our memorial and the 'Rosmarein strauß' double auction - two beautifully decorated Rosemary bouquets from our Miss Schwaben and Mr. Schwaben. Each of our Kinder and Jugend have their own decorated Rosemary which will be center pieces for their family tables. This is going to be an event you don't want to miss!

And yes, our meal will feature some traditional Donauschwaben foods!

What is Kirchweih? It is of one our most traditional Donauschwaben festivals. Kirchweih is an event celebrated throughout Europe in various ways. It celebrates the Blessing of the church and is often held on a weekend during September or October. Each village celebrated with a trachten parade, church service which included a Blessing from the clergy, a meal and family gatherings.

The Trachten parade marched through the village streets, stopping at various homes where the homeowner honoured the marchers with food and drink. There were poems read and various songs sung. The parade could take an hour though the church was only a few minutes walk from any point of the village. The marches were led by a musician or a brass band and welcomed all to join in the march. Eventually, the parade made its way to the church where the Clergy blessed the Church and the village.

The decorated Rosemary strauß would be auctioned off and the festival included a homemade style meal and a community dance. Sometimes the celebration would last more than two days with other activities being added - such as the Kirchweih market, the 'Sweet Market', carnival style rides and games of chance.

How to decorate your Rosemary.

If you are representing a region, your Rosemary strauß/ bouquet would showcase this village's style. Some regions had every inch of the green plant decorated in large wide ribbons, from top to bottom. It looked like a walking Ribbon tree! Other regions decorated with ribbons and bows, some leaving the top of the plant empty of all decorations, while others only added a few ribbons showing more of the greenery.

How you choose to decorate your Rosemary strauß, it is a strong symbol of the Donauschwaben culture and tradition. Taken from the Hans Gehl book, 'Rosemary in the Life of the Danube Swabians", the Rosmarein is a symbol of love and faith and is used in many of life's celebrations from baptism, weddings, festivals, and death. This is a folksong taken from his work and is known in the Jahrmarkt (Banat) region:

Rosmarein, Rosmarein, you will always be with us. When we're laughing under the maypole and bring that festival to life,

When we get married and put that ring on our finger, And when we gather after someone's last hours,

It serves us at the dead one's bier as it once did in our young years.

Can't wait to see your decorated Rosemary strauß at our Kirchweih on September 17th! See the poster for more details!

REMINDER – KIRCHWEIH strauß-decorating for ALL UNTERGRUPPEN will be held on Thursday, September 15th at the Club, time will be announced to groups closer to the date. Frauengruppe members will be available to assist those wishing to decorate their strauß with ribbons, bows, etc..
