3. *Cultural* – cultural activities and events, contact for Cultural groups to the board

 4. *Entertainment* – social activities and events, board contact for group affiliated with the club.
5. *Membership* – updating your address/email information. Sick benefit budget and finances.

6. *Communication* – advertising online or in the Nachrichten, switching how you receive the Nachrichten (or getting a copy if you do not already).

7. *Treasurer* – operational budget and finances.

8. *Haus and Hof* – repairs and maintenance to the building and lands. How to cut grass.

9. *Archive* – requests for club branded clothing and materials. Access to historical materials.

10. *Flag Bearer* – condition of flags and other club artifacts on display.

11. *Secretary* – copies of Constitutions, Club policies and procedures.
