PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Thank you to everyone that completed the 2023 Questionnaire. We had a good number of responses from most of the age ranges (children excluded), from all membership types and Untergruppen, and from brand new through 40+ year members. Although there were a number of very insightful comments made that will be shared with the Executive, I will only be providing herein a quick overview of the overall results and more commonly stated comments:

1. People primarily joined the club either because of family connections (either Donauschwaben or German), to participate in one of the social or cultural groups, or because of a positive first experience at the club that brought them back.

2. Over 75% said the club has met their needs. Overall impression of the club received a ranking of 3.81 out of 5. Only one person gave a ranking of below 3.

3. It was an even split on if the purpose of the club has changed over time. For those that said it has changed, typically they either originally joined because of family, friends or a specific group, but have over time either created new friendships and/or gained an increased personal appreciation of their culture.

4. It was also an even split on if the purpose of the club will change for you/your family in the future. For those that said it will change, typically they hope to have their own children be part of the club and share in the positive experiences.

5. When asked to rate various different elements of the club, areas that needed improvement were the website/social media, the Nachrichten and service of the Executive. Location of the building, condition/appearance of the building and lands, and service of the staff were positive.

6. Areas of improvement that were repeatedly expressed included having more all ages and/or lower cost social events, having more events in the Biergarten in the summer (possibly with live entertainment), and increasing opportunities to learn about the Donauschwaben culture.

7. Repeated specific recommendations included improving exterior lighting and access to the back yard parking lot, improving the quality of the meals, upgrading the social media to promote the social aspect (to entice new members), and discouraging the entitled/poor attitude of select members.

8. Specific social events that received the highest interest were Oktoberfest Family Day,

Cooking Classes, evening campfires and February Family Day. Mayfest, German lessons, fishing tournaments, Donauschwabentag, Weinlesefest, Easter Egg Hunt and Schnitzengiggle were requested. A "New Members Night" was an interesting concept to let new members learn more about what the club is about and meet everyone.

9. A "suitable" price for a dinner/dance ranged from \$25 to \$60, with the majority being around \$30 to \$40. Attendance would increase with lower costs, as some (particularly families and those with lower incomes) cannot afford to go. The concept of subsidizing events was an even split; who received the subsidy varied from club members (to promote attendance to cultural events) to volunteers (as a thank you for helping) to non-club members (to encourage them to attend).

10. There was slightly more no's on placing an expectation on members to volunteer.

11. There is a desire to keep the club around as long as possible, but also an underlying fear that the club will only remain for between 10 and 30 years. The fear is based on membership retention and not financial concerns.

As I said above, there were many insightful comments made. I hope, over the next 2 years, to improve everyone's experience at the club while increasing the awareness of our culture.
