Our cultural event for March is Miss Schwaben, which is always popular with the membership. For those looking to go, please note that part of the competition will take place in front of the membership (in the

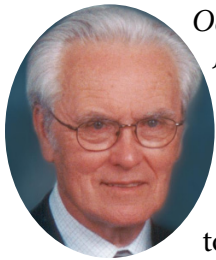

Membership renewal for 2023 deadline has passed. Now a \$30 late processing fee will be applied to renewals.

Clarification of fees:

Two adults in the same household is considered a Family membership.

All members of the family up to the age of 21 living at the same address is considered a family.

A single senior membership commences in the year the senior turns 66 years of age.

Students can be under family membership but must be living at home and going to school until age 25. If they finish school before 25, they must pay single membership.

Miss & Mr. Schwaben: Applicant must be a club member in good standing for at least one year or applicant can be under family membership living at home.

Any person age 16 or older or any child from a family membership may become their own member and eventually are eligible to vote starting at 18 years old. If they are going to school they would pay Student membership.

At the age of 18 the member is eligible to vote after having been a member for a full three months.
