

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

When we first moved to our new location in 2021, one of the first things that was done (at the request of some members) was the creation of a business plan. Within the business plan we outlined amongst other things (A) how we plan to maintain the purpose of the club, being the promotion of the our German cultural heritage and language; (B) how the board and staff run club events, fundraising initiatives and rentals, and (C) defined our staff (full time, volunteer and part time) needs. On Wednesday November 29th @ 7 p.m. is our next Sick Benefit meeting, and my plan is to revisit the business plan given that we now have over two years at our new location; a business plan is a living document that needs to be reviewed and updated as needed. There are two primary reasons I think this is important to revisit the business plan right now. The first is that in September we almost had to cancel Kirchweih because of lack of attendance; Kirchweih is one of the fundamental cultural events of the year, so the question needs to be asked "what do we need to do to increase participation in these types of events"? The second reason is we are having a very difficult time filling positions (including paid positions) during events; how can we improve things?

To set the tone, the meeting is intended to reflect on the challenges of the past, but only as needed to bring forward ideas (solutions) for the future. I encourage all Sick Benefit members to come out and help shape the future of the club.
