PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Happy New Year everyone,

The Christmas Potluck was a great success; it was a great way to end 2023. Thank you to Thomas for organizing the event, and for everyone that assisted with the day. There was a wide variety of foods to sample, and no one went home hungry. Attendees young and old enjoyed themselves, and the 'spirit of Christmas joy' was in abundance.

At the last Sick Benefit meeting in 2023, updates to the Business Plan were presented for approval; the Business Plan fundamentally summarizes how the club will be managed in 2024. Some of the key updates include:

Katie was an admired cook, baker and enthusiastic supporter of the Schwaben Club.

Katie had fond memories of like-minded people who shared the same background, ideas and recipes. She moved here from Windsor in 1993 with her husband to be closer to her daughter and grandchildren.

She was born in Bacsalmas, Hungary, a few kilometres from the Yugoslavian border. Schwaben, Hungarians and Serbians all got along until about 1941-1942 when the unpleasantness started among the three ethnic groups. The Donauschwaben were hardworking, God-fearing people who respected their elders. They went to church celebrations during Advent and Lent without question. Names day was held dear and St. Katherine's saying was "Katrine schliesst die Geige in".

Katie came to Canada in 1952 as a bride to meet her fiancé and in 31 days they were married according to the laws at the time.

Her favourite dishes included noodles and dumplings with vegetables or fruit; chicken or meat was only eaten once or twice a week.

Katie hopes the next generations maintain the culture, values and German language. Her daughter learned German at home and in school and it helped her secure a position flying to Frankfurt with Air Canada which she has held for over 30 years.

The Schwaben were well-recognized by other nations like Hungary and Empress Maria Theresia for their hard work in the fields producing wheat, rye and corn on good soil.

Katie brought with her from Germany pots and pans, a featherbed and pillows as she did not know what to expect in her new home country.
