PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Over the last year I have been making the point of getting out and attending events at the local German Clubs, and the Canada / US Schwaben Clubs, to both show our support and to see / hear what is working (and not working) at their clubs. I've also talked to members of those unfortunate clubs that are closing their doors to see what they would have done differently. What I have found is those clubs that are successful have been able to get younger people involved. The obvious benefit is maintaining membership numbers, but more importantly it (A) allows for the transfer of knowledge, heritage and experience, (B) develops future leaders through succession planning, and (C) offers the senior members the ability to slow down and relax a little more, and not burn out.

What I ask of the membership is to promote the club to family and friends so we keep our club and our heritage alive. We can be financially stable for a long time, but we need to keep the club operable (i.e. we need people willing to help keep the club going). We do have some younger people stepping up and being more active, but we cannot place our future survival on a handful of people. As the saying goes "more hands make lighter work".

On a similar track, planning is already underway with KW Oktoberfest Inc and local stakeholders regarding Oktoberfest 2024 and beyond. I, like many others, can remember KWO during its heyday – it was a unique week long community wide festival that brought tourists in from wide and far. Now "Oktoberfest" events can be found everywhere, we have lost the notoriety and large scale tourist draw, and with it the large scale sponsorship. What I hope to see in the future is the Festhallen working with KW Oktoberfest Inc to promote to the communities outside of KW (Toronto, Hamilton, London) a realistic Bavarian festival which includes food,

drink, entertainment and culture; in other words, something more than just a themed party at the local pub or micro brewery. The Festhallen will provide the heritage and venues, while KW Oktoberfest Inc will provide the expanded marketing and promotion. Hopefully we can come together for the common good or risk losing out on the parade, open ceremonies and other community events that KW Oktoberfest provides.
